



Volunteer Opportunity Description

Title: Activity Leader

Purpose/Objective: Positively relate to a child/children in one of HCFC's residential homes. To lead an activity in various available subject areas, that will engage, educate and expose the children to new and different experiences and interests.

Location: on-campus or virtual

Key Responsibilities: Be a positive role model; spend time engaged with a group of children/teens leading an activity or teaching a topic with patience and positive communication. The Activity Leader will report any problems or concerns to the on-duty Family Teacher or the Community Engagement Manager within 24 hours.

Impact/Goal: Introduce new activities, experiences, or hobbies to a group of children; building individual and team skills, positive interactions and relationships and developing interest and growth in new directions.

Qualifications: Knowledge in the area of the activity and ability to convey that information effectively and patiently with children/teens. Volunteer will supply equipment/material for the activity.

Time Commitment: Activity Leaders have the ability to volunteer at their own pace, but should plan for a one-hour minimum per activity.

Training/Support Provided: Activity details must be approved by the Community Engagement Manager prior to setting up the activity. HCFC will reserve and set up a room for the activity as requested.

Benefits: HCFC's children are exposed to new experiences and build relationships with positive role models in the Activity Leader and/or assisting volunteers. Volunteers gain experience working with youth, teaching and building cultural competency.
